

SHEEP SCAB & DIPPING:

Scab continues for present a challenge to all sheep producers in Wales. The Welsh Government has announced that it will set aside £5m for a project to try and eradicate the problem. In the meantime the association needs to make sure that sheep sold at our sales are free from scab. Members are reminded that when considering the options for treating sheep against scab or lice before sale that no product is licensed to be used for scab by showering.

If scab is suspected by sale inspectors, <u>all</u> the sheep entered by a member will have to be immediately withdrawn. They may be removed from the sale yard without the owners consent if the owner is not present. (Please see Rule 29 of the Conditions of sale entry & declaration 1 of the sale entry forms.)
